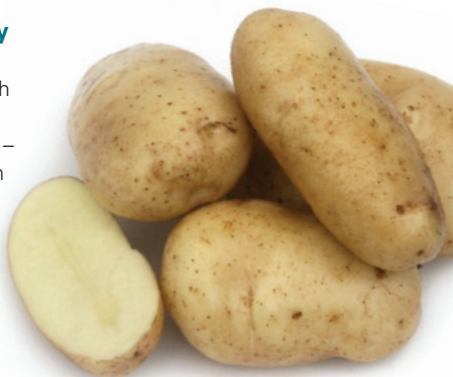
Early Maincrop

Consumer quality

Elland is an early-maincrop variety with excellent processing characteristics. Oval – long-oval tubers with shallow eyes ideally suited for chipping. Regular tuber shape and skin brightness give potential in the pre-pack sector.



Agronomic features

Elland produces high yields of regular-shaped tubers. Elland has resistance to PCN *G. pallida* as well as bruising and external damage. Elland shows excellent resistance to C. scab and Blackleg as well as most skin blemish diseases.
