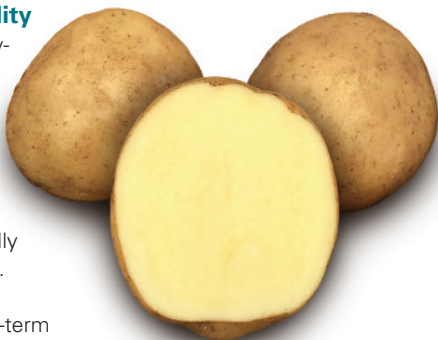
## Early Maincrop

(Olympus x 98-HIG-16.4)



### Consumer quality

Lorimer is an early-maincrop variety with excellent processing characteristics, round-oval tubers with shallow eyes ideally suited for crisping. Suitable for low temperature, long-term storage with low reducing sugar accumulations and acrylamide formation.



### Agronomic features

Lorimer produces high yields from reduced input levels. Lorimer has resistance to PCN *G. rostochiensis* as well as bruising and external damage. Lorimer shows excellent resistance to Skin spot and Spraing as well as most skin blemish diseases.
