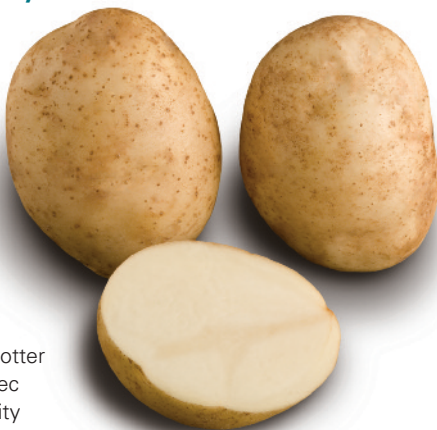


Consumer quality

Predominately grown for fresh market consumption but also used in the Far East for crisping.

Agronomic features

Moderate to high yield of large oval tubers suited to hotter climates. Kennebec maintains its quality throughout storage.
